#### INTRODUCTION

Governor Andrew Cuomo established the Countywide Shared Services Initiative ("CWSSI") in the FY18 State Budget with the stated intent of generating tax savings through inter-government collaboration. This statewide initiative requires the chief executive officers in the 57 counties outside of New York City to convene Shared Services Panels for the purpose of identifying and developing shared services projects. The projects are then then incorporated into a Shared Services Plan and put up for a vote by the Shared Services Panel.

The Shared Services Panel must consist of the chief executive officer of every city, town and village in the county. For Genesee County, this creates a working Shared Services Panel of at least 21 officials. This panel could be expanded to include any school district, board of cooperative educational services, fire protection or special district representatives in the county. Development of a Shared Services Plan also requires the input from the public, and from civic, business and labor leaders.

The Countywide Shared Services Initiative (CWSSI) requires the County Manager to convene at least two (2) panel meetings and three (3) public hearings in advance of a submission of the Shared Services Plan to New York State. The process will be organized and administered by the County and the intergovernmental panel will be chaired by the County Manager, L. Matthew Landers.

The goal of the CWSSI is to save property taxpayers money, by identifying collaborative opportunities for shared services between as many local governments as possible. Prospects for both short-term and long-term savings should be considered.

## **KEY ROLES & RESPONSIBILITES**

#### Role of the County Manager's Office

- Staff the panel and represent the County and its residents
- Commence meetings and consult with the required panel members
- Organize public hearings and topical meetings with key strategic partners
- Develop and submit the plan, estimated Cost Savings Certification for County Legislature review
- Submit the final approved plan with certification to the NYS Division of the Budget
- Present the final approved plan to the public

#### Role of Municipal Partners (City, Town and Village Representatives)

- Represent their local government and residents on the Shared Services Panel
- Participate in plan development and provide local costs and savings estimates
- Collaborate with other panel members and recommend actions for implementation
- Determine if your municipality should opt-out of any actions proposed in the plan
- Vote on the plan and provide written reasons for your vote

#### **Plan Contents**

The plan must contain new, recurring property tax savings from actions such as, but not limited to:

- Elimination of duplicative services;
- Shared Services, such as joint purchasing, shared highway equipment, shared storage facilities, shared plowing services, and energy and insurance pushing cooperatives;
- Reductions in administrative overhead; and
- Better coordination of services.

Savings from each new plan action implemented in the applicable match year must be related to activities supported by property taxes. Net savings from services supported solely by fees are not eligible for matching funds from the state.

The final approved plan must include a certification of savings to be achieved through implementation of the shared services actions. For Genesee County's plan that will be submitted for 2022, the certified savings will be tracked and documented for **new actions taken on and after January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023.** 

## PROPOSALS FOR CONSIDERATION

PROPOSAL ONE: Sewage Transmission Line to Share Waste Treatment Plant

Participating Municipalities: Town of Darien, Town of Pembroke and Village of Corfu

Anticipated Annual Savings: \$52,735 Projected NYS Match: \$52,735

The participating municipalities will work together to combine a waste treatment plant in Corfu/Pembroke. To carry out the initiative the municipalities must finalize engineering, seek BIDS, secure funding and obtain the approval of the State Controller's Office.

Savings in expected to be realized thru the elimination of a sewer plant operation, a reduction in the amount of biochemical usage and lab work.

#### PROPOSAL TWO: Phase One - Countywide Broadband Initiative

Participating Municipalities: County of Genesee and Genesee County Towns/Villages

Anticipated Annual Savings: \$291,000 Projected NYS Match: \$291,000

Genesee County municipal leaders are collaborating in a large-scale countywide project that will bring broadband access to every mile of the County. This project is anticipated to be two-phased initiative, with Phase One beginning in 2023.

The savings is being recognized through collaboration. Pooling the projects together will result in a lower cost from the vendor rather than implementing these improvements individually.

WHEREAS, the Genesee County Manager did reconvene the countywide Shared Services Panel, and


WHEREAS, Genesee County municipal leaders did present proposals for consideration to be submitted in the 2022 Shared Services Plan to the New York State Department of State, and
